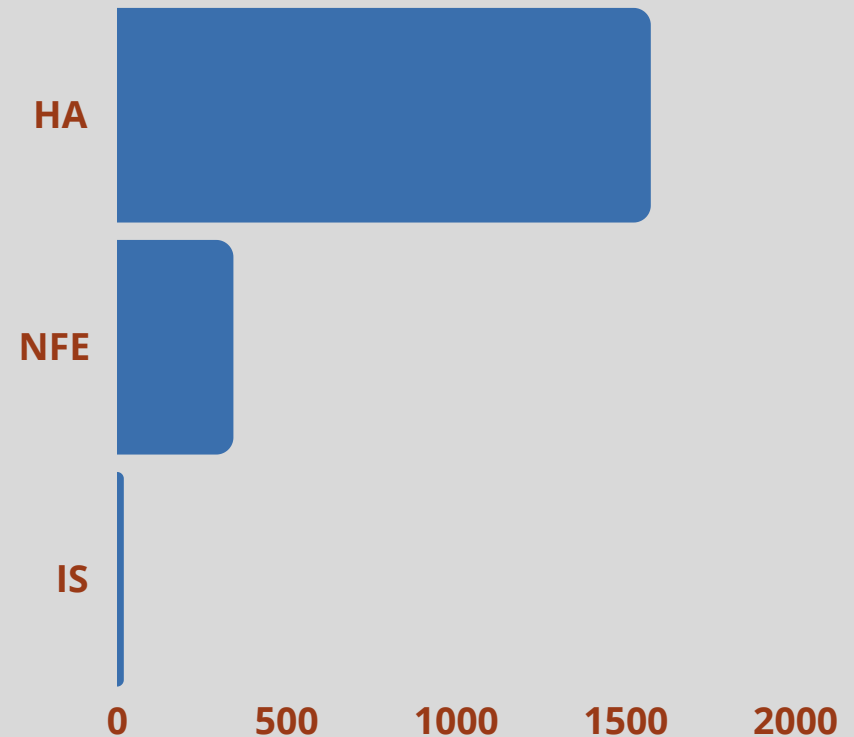

The first month of our reduced operational capacities, in an attempt to re-structure and ensure sustainability has been successful, a renewed look on existing operations and looking ahead has been the focus.

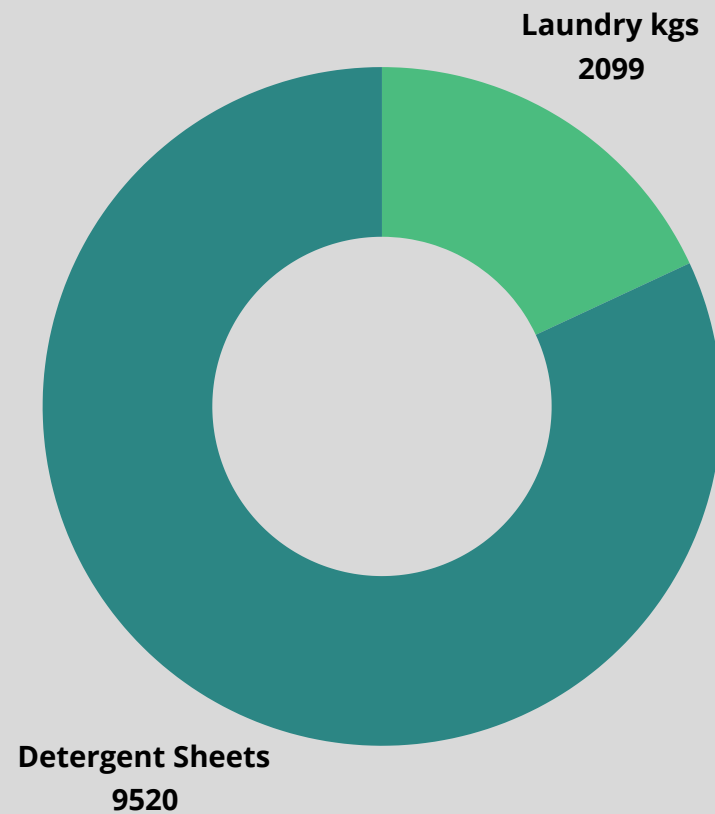


Humanitarian Aid

A total of 11,619

NFI, FI and services were distributed in March to 1,573 visitors on Lesbos

A total of 9,520 detergent sheets for laundry were distributed on Lesbos while 2,099 kgs of clothing were washed as well.

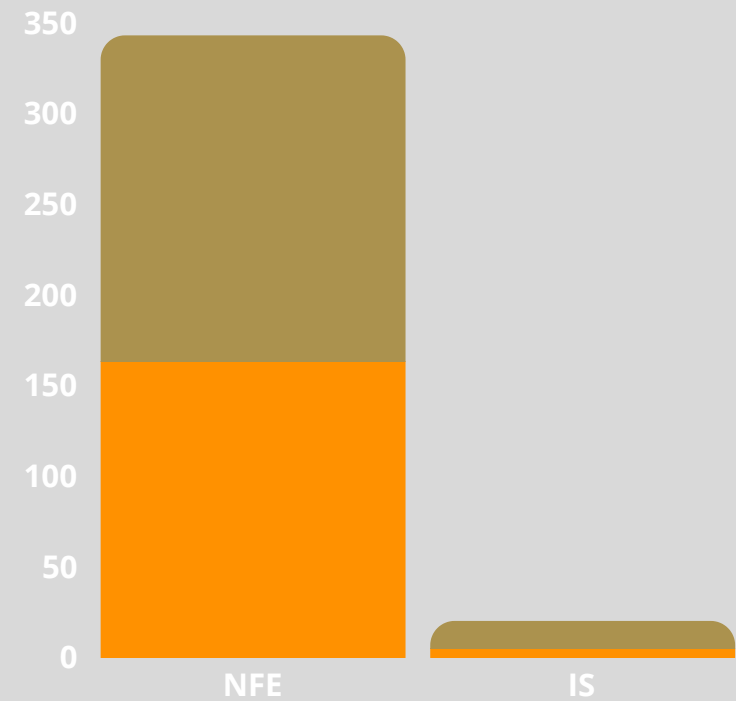


Community Engagement

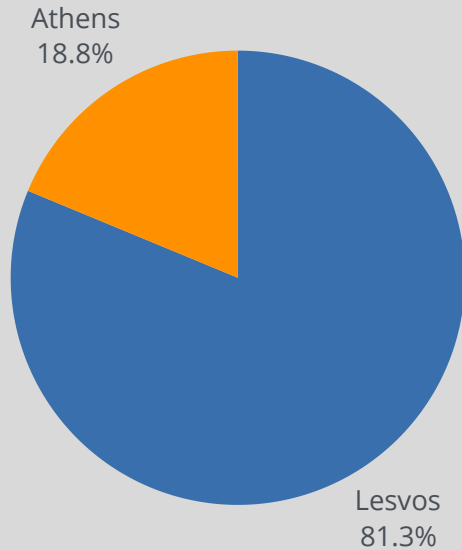

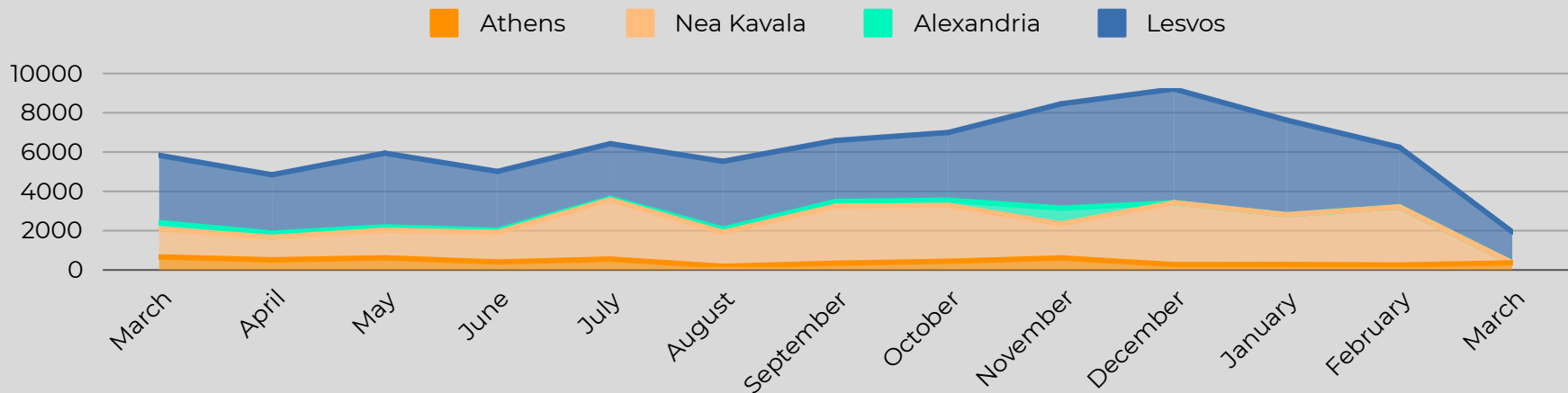


Total visitors by location

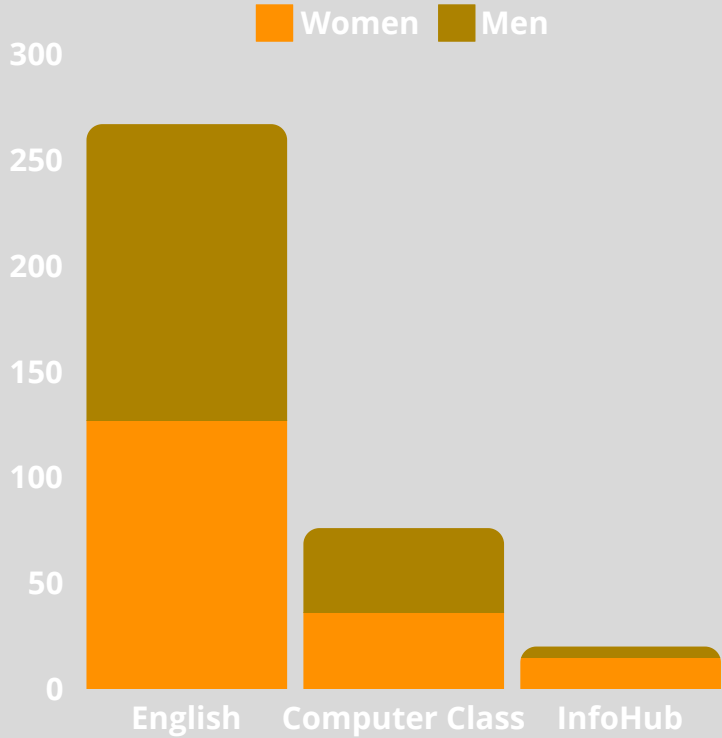

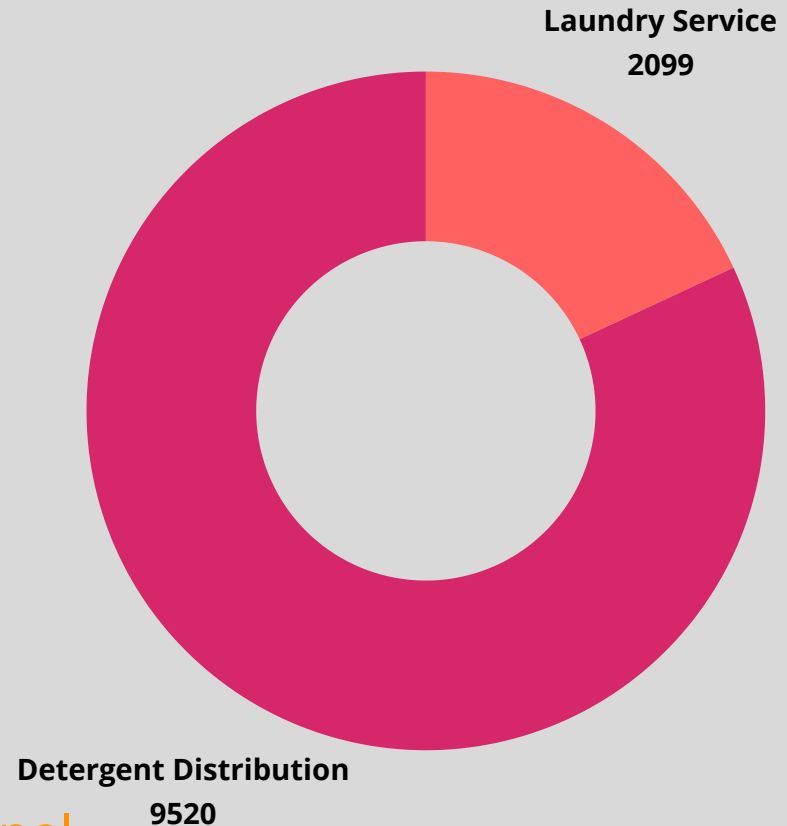

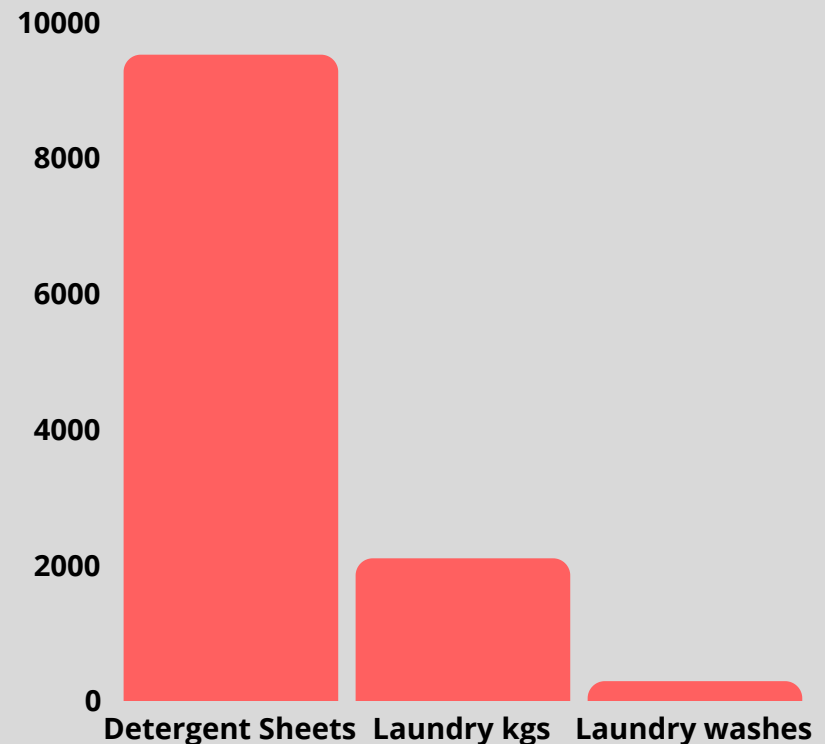


Humanitarian Aid

A total of 1,753

visitors benefited from our WASH services in March on the island of Lesvos

Collaborating within the medical protocol to also ensure skin diseases and health-related issues are treated appropriately. A total of 89 referral requests provided 723kg worth of washed clothes directed to this purpose.
